Itinerary

April 13, 2023 - Your Mediterranean Riviera Adventure Begins!

Today you'll board your flight to **Barcelona, Spain**, beginning the trip of a lifetime!

April 14, 2023 - Welcome to Barcelona!

On arrival, you'll be met by your **TRIPS** representative and embark on your **panoramic city tour of Barcelona**, a true cosmopolitan masterpiece! With a history rich in art and architecture, medieval, Gothic, and modern influences can be seen all over this alluring city. From the **shady, tree-lined Las Ramblas Boulevard** to the Museu Picasso and Fundació Joan Miró museums to the sandy beaches near the harbor, there's no end to the riches of Barcelona. April 16, 2023 - Fine Wines and Dali: Port-Vendres, France

The Catalan fishing town of **Port-Vendres** sits just over the Spanish border on the Côte Vermeille in southwest France, overlooking its picturesque harbor's boats on the Mediterranean. Stepping off the ship at this tender port, where you'll be from **7:30am to 6pm**, you'll find truly enticing options. You could head to **Cadaqués**, a charming town that was once home to the **artist Salvador Dali**. Be sure to visit his world-famous museum while you're there. Or simply hang out in quaint Port-Vendres and enjoy the local sights with perhaps a **fresh seafood lunch** paired with the **region's renowned Collioure wines!** (B/L/D)

April 17, 2023 - Gateway to Provence: Marseille, France

You'll dock in the great ancient port of **Marseille** from **8am to 10pm**, where 2,600 years of history come to life. Grit and grandeur coexist seamlessly in this exuberantly multicultural city with a pedigree going back to classical Greece. The Musée des Civilisations de l'Europe et de la Méditerranée offers fascinating insights on the culture of this seaside region. While here, you can explore **La Panier** for shops and souvenirs galore, and cap off your day with a refreshing **glass of pastis** - a local favorite with a kick! Or you might want to spend the day out exploring the **quaint country markets** and **luscious lavender fields** of the enchanting **Provence countryside!** (B/L/D)

April 18, 2023 - Seafood Delights: Sanary Sur Mer, France

While you're tendered in to **Sanary Sur Mer** from **8am to 8pm**, you might choose to visit église Saint Nazaire, a late 19th century Gothic Revival church, or Chapelle Notre-Dame-de-Pitié, built in 1560. As you

stroll along the palm-lined harbor, you'll find rows of old Provençal wooden fishing boats - or as the locals call them, **pointus** - and if you're lucky, you'll also find local fishermen selling the day's catch. This is the perfect place to enjoy the **freshest seafood imaginable** at any number of Sanary's restaurants in this charming and inviting town. (B/L/D)

April 19 and 20, 2023 - Overnight in Nice, France

As a key highlight of this itinerary, you'll be docked **overnight in Nice** from **8am** on the 19th, to **9pm** on the 20th. On this special extended two-day visit, you'll find that **Nice** is not just a "nice" place to explore, nor is it simply the home of the **world's most prestigious film festival!** With its four miles of brightly pebbled coastline along the **Promenade des Anglais**, Nice claims one of the longest and most famous beaches of the Riviera.
