

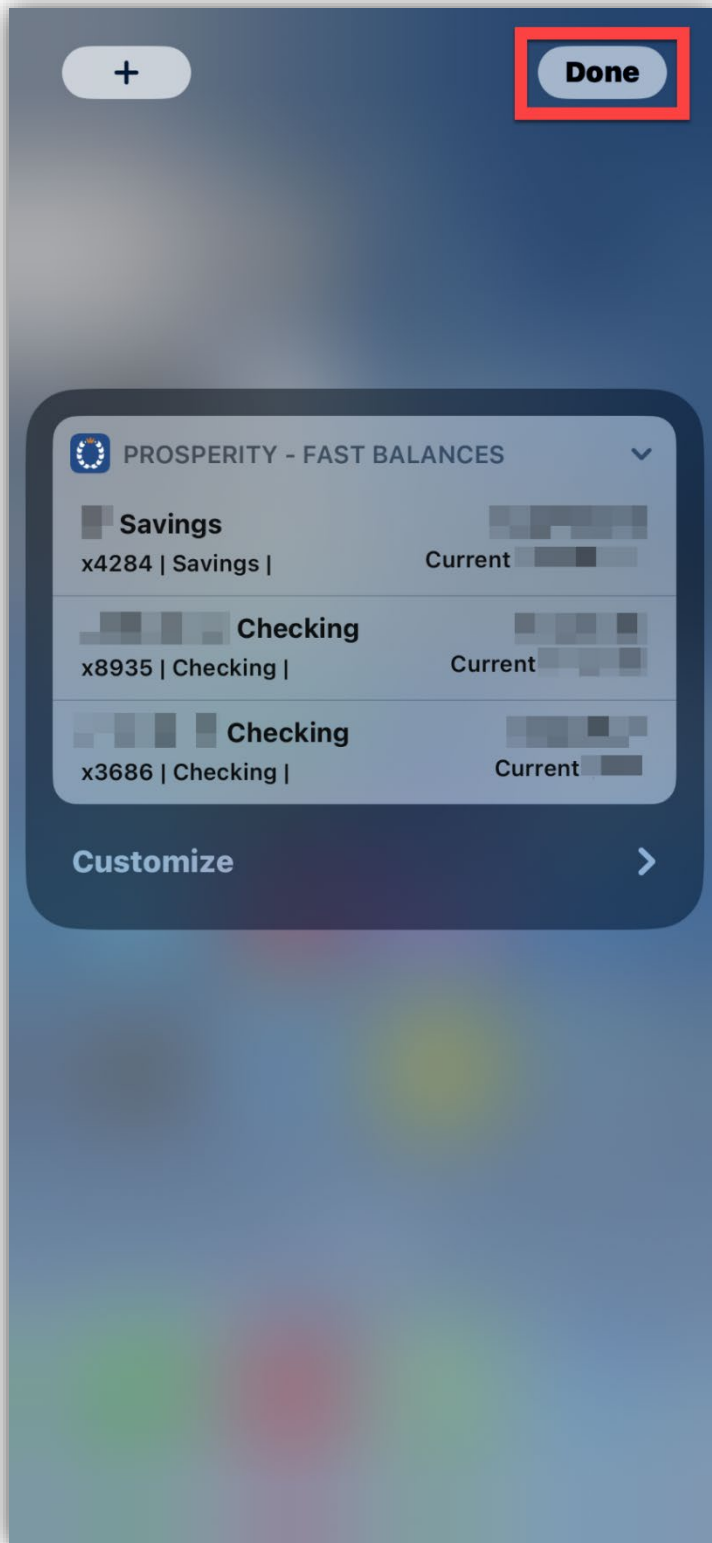


Prosperity - Fast Balances will move to the top section. Select Done (top right).



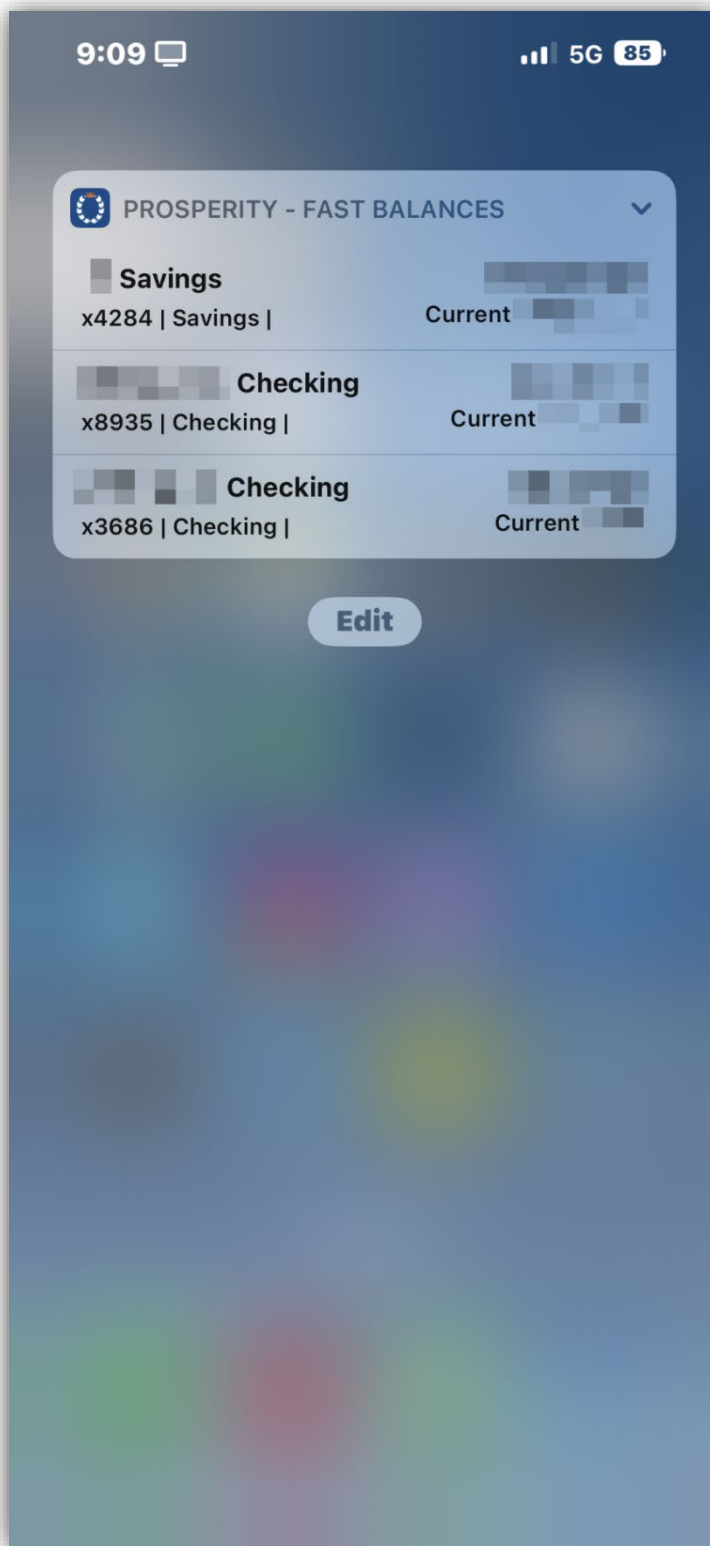


The new widget will appear. Click Done (top right).
