Today, it takes 8-10 hours to transit the canal passing through steel lock gates that are 6 feet thick and 60 feet tall. The original 40 pairs of gates, built in Pennsylvania, are still in use after more than 100 years. This engineering wonder is truly one you'll find endlessly fascinating to explore!

Itinerary

January 26, 2024 - Your Journey Begins!

You'll fly today to **Miami, Florida**, where you'll be met and assisted with your hotel transfer, and then enjoy tonight's dinner on your own.

January 27, 2024 - Board the Norwegian Bliss

After a leisurely hotel breakfast this morning, you'll transfer to your seafaring hotel, the **Norwegian Bliss**, in time for a late lunch. Unpack just once for all 15 days, before sailing away at **5:30 pm**. (B/D)

January 28 & 29, 2024 - First Two Days At Sea

What a treat to kick off your cruise in high style - **two luxurious sea days** to fully explore and enjoy the **Norwegian Bliss**, your five-star floating resort with an amazing variety of things to do - or do nothing at all! Find that perfect spot by the pool and relax with a good book or a nap. Or step it up at the outdoor jogging/walking track and fully equipped fitness center. If you prefer being pampered, stop in at the **Mandara Spa** for a massage or mani/pedi. Enjoy dinner in one of the many wonderful options onboard the Bliss - from the variety of your three Main Dining Rooms to the specialty restaurants serving everything from steak and seafood to tapas, Teppanyaki or Texas BBQ! Evenings offer a world of entertainment as well, with performances of the **celebrated Broadway hits "Six" and "Jersey Boys"** or the Beatles-themed tunes at the Cavern Club. January 30, 2024 - Cartagena, Colombia

At **6am** you'll dock in **Cartagena**, located on Colombia's northern coast and one of the Western Hemisphere's most historic cities. You might explore the old city's **Simon Bolivar Square** and **Plaza de La Aduana**, and wander the narrow streets with their restored buildings, cafes and shops. Or stop at a local museum, enjoy a delicious cup of Colombian coffee or just stroll along **Las Murallas** (the walls surrounding the city). There's much to see plus enough time for shopping in one of the bustling markets. Return to your ship in time for your **2pm** sailing. (B/L/D)

January 31, 2024 - Full Day Transit of the Panama Canal!

Your ship enters the **Panama Canal from the Atlantic / Caribbean side** this morning for a **full daytime transit of the canal!** Construction on the 48 mile canal that connects the Atlantic and Pacific

began in 1881 and was completed 33 years later in 1914. After several unsuccessful attempts by the French, US engineers took control of building the canal and the US retained ownership until 1999 when Panama assumed full control. Named one of the **seven wonders of the modern world**, nearly 15,000 ships per year travel through the canal! What once were the tops of lush hills now make up the many **rainforest covered islands dotting Gatun Lake on the Canal**. Pass through a series of locks that are flooded and emptied to raise and lower the Bliss as it makes its way through the Canal. Towing locomotives operating on cog tracks keep the ship centered within the lock chamber, and watching the process is truly amazing. After an exciting day of cruising the Canal, you'll be on **Panama's West Coast / Pacific Ocean side!** (B/L/D)

January 31 & February 1, 2024 - Panama City, Panama

This evening at **8pm on the 31st**, just after your day-long transit of the great canal, you'll dock overnight at **Panama City**. This vibrant historic metropolis and gateway to Pacific Ocean tropical adventures has much for you to discover! Founded in 1519, Panama City is the **oldest continuously occupied European settlement** on the Americas' Pacific Coast. Explore the region's dramatic past at historic sites enveloped by the busy cosmopolitan atmosphere. Or feel a world away while lounging on a **pristine beach**, or hiking through **lush rainforests** that are home to a vivid assortment of colorful flora and fauna. The Bliss sails the next afternoon at **3pm on the 1st**. (B/L/D)

February 2, 2024 - At Sea on the Bliss

After three days of spectacular sightseeing, you'll have this one to unwind and enjoy the many delicious tastes, entertainment and activities of the **Norwegian Bliss**. Take a stroll on the promenade and meet friends for a game of shuffleboard. Indulge in delicious cannoli and cupcakes from **The Bake Shop**. If you're in the mood for a cocktail on a warm sunny day, there's no place like adults-only **Spice H2O**. And if so inclined, don't forget to pack those dancing shoes to party into the night! February 3, 2024 - Puerto Quetzal, Guatemala

After docking at **12 noon**, you might opt for an excursion to one of Guatemala's most popular destinations, the **UNESCO heritage city of Antigua**. Early Spanish Baroque architecture is the main attraction of this colonial city, as you wander along the cobblestoned streets and find charming photo ops seemingly around every corner! Closer to port, you'll find the bustling **Puerto Quetzal market** selling crafts and souvenirs,

with Marimba band performances! The Bliss sails at **10pm**. (B/L/D)

February 4, 2024 - Freestyle at Sea

Norwegian's **Freestyle Cruising** offers a wide range of amenities, activities, restaurants and entertainment, all designed to let you do exactly what you want to do. Choose among more than 20 dining and lounge options, a soothing spa and an always lively casino. (B/L/D)

February 5, 2024 - Acapulco, Mexico

Today finds you in **Acapulco** from **7am** to **5pm**, with its stunning topography of soaring cliffs, sandy beaches and jungle-green hills. Dubbed the '**Pearl of the Pacific**,' Acapulco has long been a playground for the rich and famous, starting with Frank Sinatra, Elvis Presley and Elizabeth Taylor. Acapulco's most famous tradition is the **cliff divers** who leap from 148-foot cliffs high above the rocky shoreline! (B/L/D)

February 6, 2024 - Bliss At Sea
